BRETT NORELL NAMED VICE PRESIDENT OF FINANCE AT FSCC SPONSORED MINISTRIES

MANITOWOC, WIS. — We are pleased to announce that Brett Norell has been named vice president of finance and CFO at Manitowoc, Wis.-based Franciscan Sisters of Christian Charity (FSCC) Sponsored Ministries, effective December 1, 2017. Norell will replace James Vopat who has served in this role since 1988 and will be retiring March 1, 2018.

“We are excited to be welcoming Brett as our vice president of finance. Since 2015, Norell has been vice president of finance and CFO at Holy Family Memorial, an affiliate of FSCC Sponsored Ministries located in Manitowoc. Prior to that, he worked for several years at Children’s Hospital of Wisconsin, Milwaukee, in a variety of operations positions as well as the operations and project director to the president and most recently as director of decision support. Norell is a fellow in the American College of Healthcare Executives and holds master’s degrees in health administration and public health from the University of Iowa in Iowa City.

The Franciscan Sisters of Christian Charity Sponsored Ministries is a not-for-profit corporation that was established in 1985 (formerly named Franciscan Sisters of Christian Charity HealthCare Ministry) to monitor and manage the health care ministry organizations of the Congregation of the Franciscan Sisters of Christian Charity. The health care ministry spans three states—Wisconsin, Nebraska and Ohio—and has existed for over 100 years. In 2012, the name was changed to Franciscan Sisters of Christian Charity Sponsored Ministries to reflect the addition of the congregation’s Silver Lake College of the Holy Family, located in Manitowoc, to the corporation.
